MEMORY VERSE: Philippians 2:8 He humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death- even to death on a Cross.

MAIN POINT: People welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem as their King.

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: What did Jesus do to save us?

SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS:

1. Why did Jesus send His disciples to get a donkey for Him to ride?
2. What word did the people and the children say in praise of Jesus?
3. Where did Jesus go to spend the night?

CHRIST CONNECTION:

During Jesus' triumphal entry, the people welcomed Him as King. Jesus was the Messiah spoken about by the prophet Zechariah: "Look, your King is coming to you; He is righteous and victorious, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey" (Zechariah 9:9). One day, Jesus will return to earth on a white horse as King over everything.

When we have faith in Jesus, He is the King of our lives. Someday He will come back and set up His perfect kingdom on earth forever.
